Designs of projects to be entrusted to
the Central Designs Organisation.

In the above Government Orders the procedure regarding the preparation of drawings and designs of Major/Irrigation/Hydro Projects have been laid down for the Central Designs Organisation and field officers. It is decided to compile the orders in one form for guidance to the Central Designs Organisation and Field Officer under Irrigation Department.

2. As per the present orders, the nature of work of Central Designs Organisation is as under :-

- i) Initial work of project investigation and approval from Central Water Commission/Central Electricity Authority is done by project investigation circles. The work of preparation of detailed designs and drawings with respective designs reports of various components of major irrigation and hydro projects is to be carried out by Central Designs Organisation with coordination of all the regions, after collecting required data from field officers.
- ii) Preparation of detailed designs and drawing for the head works of Medium and Minor Irrigation Projects having heights more than 30.00 metres or having special problems.
- iii) Preparation of designs of spillways for heads 12 m more than 3.5 metres or a fall of 10 m or more.
- iv) Design of head regulators having head of 14 m or more.
- v) Designs and planning of canal structures of major problems where the structure is costing more than Rs.50.00 lakhs.
- vi) Examination and approval to the designs of canal structures, prepared by the contractor.
- vii) Designs for strengthening of the construction of dams from design point.
- viii) Special problems related to designs and allied issues of any completed project or during the construction are to be studied in Central Designs Organisation and remedial measures suggested as per Govt. directives.
- ix) Design flood studies of all major and medium projects which are referred to Central Designs Organisation.

x) Guidance to the field officers for Central Water Commission
compliance on Hydrology.

The above functions of the Central Designs Organisation
are based on various Government orders issued from time to time
now it is decided that the proposals of drawing and design in case
as detailed below will be submitted by Central Design Organisation
to Government for approval.

MAJOR PROJECTS INCLUDING HYDRO PROJECTS.

(A)

1. General layout of earth dam with foundation data, COT and zoning, drainage.
2. Overall layout of headworks including outlets and spillway with approach and tail channels.
3. General layout of masonry dam with zoning and gal layout and special treatment for item like seepage preventional, special foundation treatment etc.
4. General layout of spillway with approach and tail channel.
5. General layout of outlets (Irrigation, Power and Water Supply) with their approach and tail channel, Hoist room and Energy Dissipation arrangements.
6. Instrumentation in dams, layout drawings, showing locations and types.
7. Non-standardised gates, their layout drawings or gate drawings or proposals for new standardization of gates.
8. Any non-conventional design for head work components and canal structures costing more than Rs.25 Lacs.
9. Canal structures costing more than Rs.50 lakhs or design involving any special site features.
10. Overall layout of the hydro project.
11. Layout of intake structure for power outlet.
12. Designs of head race funnel, Pressure shaft etc.
13. Design of surge, if any.
14. Design of tail race funnel and tail surge, if any.
15. Permits, in respect of Hydro works.
16. In addition to the above items for hydro projects, proposals involving major changes in the approach layout like tunnel replacing a canal, addition or omission of lining to the conduit or a canal, under ground power houses in place of surface ones, number of penstocks etc.
17. Any (Major, Medium or Minor) design items referred to Central Design Organisation by outside bodies as consultation job.

(B)

MEEDIUM PROJECTS : The designs for components of projects which satisfy the requirements of Sr. No. to (1X) in para 2 above.

(c) any special designs i.e. not covered in para 3 and 4 above but about the design of which advice of Central Design Organisation is considered necessary by Superintendent Engineer and which the Superintendent Engineer or the Regional Organisation would like to receive special instructions.

(d) designs not covered in para 3 and 4 above which are labelled by the State offices.

5. All designs pertaining to General Buildings, Irrigation and not covered in para 3 above and 4 above will be submitted by Superintending Engineers, Central Building Organisation except in cases for which Superintending Engineers, Central Building Organisation would like to get approval of Superintendent for any specific item.

6. Early programme of designs by District Engineers, Regional Organisation will be approved by State Engineers completely.

7. The above information is generally based on general operational instructions issued from time to time. The Regional Engineers have to act as per the Government Orders and also take to time taking into consideration the points mentioned in this circular.
