Of late it is observed that there is marked decline in the quality of stone masonry. At a number of places distress is being noticed in respect of masonry works, especially piers of C.I. Works of canals. Canal structures being at vulnerable locations, any distress developing during the operation of canals results in stoppage of irrigation facility and damage to crops. It is, therefore, essential to provide structures with suitable type of construction where desired quality can be maintained and the structure will give good service during operation of canals.

The issue was deliberated at length in the Chief Engineers Conference and the general consensus was in favour of provision of concrete piers for all C.D. Works over canals.

This circular is issued as per the recommendations
of the Chief Engineers' conference.
